Football Outline & Duty for Schools 2024

- **Venue:** Glenshea Park, Putāruru,
- **Dates:** Starts Saturday: May 4th - Finishes: Saturday 22nd June
- **Time:** First Round 10.00am and Second Round 10:45am
- **COACHES PICK UP YOUR SCORE CARDS & BALL** in the small hub shed inside the buckets if they are not already at your field.
 - **Ensure score cards are clearly filled in.**
- The last teams on fields are to collect results, bucket and ball returned to the small brick hub for the following week.

Middle, Senior and Intermediate Competition 2024:

- Remember that games are umpired by their coaches/managers; sort this out between yourselves at the start of the game (or to be fair half a game is shared.)
- **Due to not enough fields, I did try and get everyone to play every week but in the end a BYE game had to be added (so a different school each week won't play) this is for Middle and Senior grade only.**
- We do not play 'off-side', however blatant infringements need to be taken care of by the ref.
- Shin pads and boots or (covered footwear) are required. Mouthguards are optional.
- All Schools are required to bring their own first aid kits.
- If you have any compliments, concerns or complaints please see the principal of your child's school.
- Please find attached a brief outline of the basic rules we follow. This competition is all about taking part, having fun, and of course, a bit of competitiveness – we do not tolerate disrespect, bad language and poor sportsmanship.
- **I will need the most valuable player from each school, along with the Best & Fairest Player from each team.**
- **ASB First Kicks just the most valuable player towards the end of the season.**

Housekeeping items/Duty Team:

1. The soccer competition is a 7 a-side game. If you are unable to field 7 players you will have to play with the number you have.

2. If the team has **less** than 5 players they will have to **default** the game. Players may be **loaned** from the opposing team so that a game can be played but the score will be invalid with the team having all their players, receiving 2 points.
3. **Scoring system is 2 win, 1 draw and 0 loss.**

4. We are running on a tight time frame (20 mins each way, 2 min half time and 3 min between games) therefore games need to be played to the hooter - if you are running late you cannot keep playing after the hooter goes for the end of the game. However, you are playing to **the referee's whistle** so please wait for it to blow before finishing the game.
5. **Hooter starts at 10.00am and second round starts at 10.45am - teams need to be there on time as this will run into your game if you are late.**
6. If you are on duty, you will probably need 40 minutes to an hour for set-up, the goals take quite some time to get up- **9.00am Start. The goals are stored in the Grandstand. The cones, scorecard, bibs, hooter and megaphone are in the HUB. The "HUB" will be unlocked.**
7. Plastic goals used for fields 1,2,3 and 4 & 5 if required (grandstand shed).

FOOTBALL DUTY & LAYOUT

The Duty Team should arrive early to allow time to set up fields.

Any other parents/ teams please help if you are free.

After the last games, **ALL** teams on that field are to help put away goals at end of your game –

We need to leave our goal sets together, only disassemble tops and bottoms each week.

AS DUTY SCHOOL YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO: -

1. **Set up 5 fields** - using assembled plastic goals which only need top, and bottoms placed on them (grandstand). **Corner Flags, halfway cones bucket with ball and score cards from small hub.**
2. Blow horn/megaphone for start, half time and finish of games **(20 minutes each way with 2-minute half time and between games).**
3. **At the end of play –**
 - Put goals away. **IMPORTANT pack down of Goals "ONLY take top and bottoms out- keep goal sets assembled and place them tidily back into Hub"** ready for duty team the following week.
 - Pick up rubbish and don't forget to lock the "Hub" when finished.

Year 1&2 ASB FIRST Programme are responsible to setup own PODS/FIELDS:

- All teams are required to set up and pack away their own Pods each week, not **the duty team**. That is the Pod you play on each week from the draw.
- All gear is in the Sports Hub, you play at a separate time from the older grades having 20-minute games -bell rang by Jan Duthie or a helper.
- There are 13 teams in this Section. **Please read the draw carefully.**
- Other teams please help, as this will assist with the quick cleanup of all our set up and gear.]
